CalAIM technical assistance and processes:

- 3. Readiness Assessments (R.A.)

Technical Assistance



- Wellpath is able to provide as much, or as little technical assistance as needed. Some of the services include:
 - Assistance developing Implementation Plans and conducting a gap analysis
 - Guidance for obtaining NPI number
 - Development of processes and procedures to implement CalAIM requirements
 - Writing CalAIM policy proof of practice for R.A.
 - Multi-agency coordination for process refinement
 - Workflow design for ECM, MAT, Pharmacy services, DME
 - Training custody and healthcare

Obtaining NPI Number



- Go to website nppes.cms.hhs.gov
- Will need the following:
 - EIN number
 - Authorization in the system from the site administrator to be an authorized user for the county
 - Taxonomy to include 261QP2400X
 - There is a paper version available that we can provide

Policies and Procedures & Training



- All CalAIM requirements to be reflected in local policy
- Procedure manuals recommended if separate from policies
- Staff training on policies/ procedures is required for proof of practice
- Training materials and sign in sheets required for proof of practice



Readiness Assessment



- Required template for submission
- Detailed summary of new process for each CalAIM standard that was outlined as a "future plan" in the implementation plan
- Proof of practice required for each CalAIM standard including training materials
- Each jail location requires approval from DHCS to implement Medi-Cal billing
- CalAIM start- up happens quarterly in a cohort only.
