Program Administrator

- ▶ My Role as Program Administrator:
 - ▶ Oversees the Jail Program as a whole, and ensures requirements are met.
 - ▶ Implementing Requirements for the Reentry Initiative
 - ▶ PATH 3 Implementation plan is followed
 - ▶ Work with the Jail's Staff Service Analyst (QA) for any reporting requirements
 - ▶ Ensure that HHSA continues to work as a team with our community partners to ensure continuity of care for our clients.
 - ▶ Program Director for Jail Based Restoration of Competency (JBTC)
 - ▶ Implementing MOU with Community Partners

All services provided & Reentry Program

- ▶ Jail Based Services Provides:
 - ▶ Medical Services
 - ▶ Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)
 - ▶ Mental Health Services
 - ▶ Assessments
 - ▶ Individual Therapy
 - ▶ Psychiatry Services for JBS and JBCT
 - ▶ Referrals to Outpatient Behavioral Health Services & Outpatient Substance Use Disorder upon release
 - ▶ Warm Hand Off for initial assessment for continuity of care. PATH 3 Requirement.
 - ▶ Jail Based Restoration of Competency (JBCT)

Case Management Services

- ▶ Case Manager will be starting their role in November.
 - ▶ Funded through PATH 3 grant and written into our Implementation Plan.
- ▶ Plan(s) for Case Manager -
 - ▶ Initially the case manager will discuss needs with Medical after HRA assessment is completed.
 - ▶ They will meet with the inmate after, continue to discuss needs.
 - ▶ Complete ROIs
 - ▶ Plan linkage to resources and appointments upon release.
 - ▶ Continue linkage to initial appts that are needed post released in the short term.
 - ▶ Work with community partners and Mariposa County Behavioral Health case managers if it is determined if the service is needed.
 - ▶ Document services provided in EHR for billing.

Enhanced Care Management Permission to Share Form

- ▶ Custody staff completes the E.C.M form when incarcerated persons are released from custody.
- ▶ The E.C.M form is then scanned and emailed to Health And Human Services Department.
- ▶ During the booking process incarcerated person are asked if they are currently on Medical or Medicare.
- ▶ Medical will conduct an intake to determine what services are required while in custody.



Permission to Share Information with Enhanced Care Management (ECM)

Cal AIM will improve Medi-Cal for people with complex needs and who are facing difficult life and health circumstances. Enhanced Care Management will address clinical and non-clinical needs of the highest-need enrollees through intensive coordination of health and health-related services. It will meet enrollees wherever they are – on the street, in a shelter, in their doctor’s office, or at home. Additionally, enrollees will have connections to Community Supports to meet their social needs, including medically supportive foods or housing supports. Enrollees will have a single Enhanced Care Manager who will coordinate care and services among the physical, behavioral, dental, developmental, and social services delivery systems, making it easier for them to get the right care at the right time.

- ▶ Incarcerated patient with current prescription for MAT medications will be continued.

- ▶ Initiating MAT

DAST

- ▶ Review risks/benefits/alternatives
- ▶ Initiate treatment (buprenorphine, goal is LAI)
- ▶ Refer to clinician for OUD counseling/ Mental health
- ▶ Consents/ Mental health assessment
- ▶ Labs

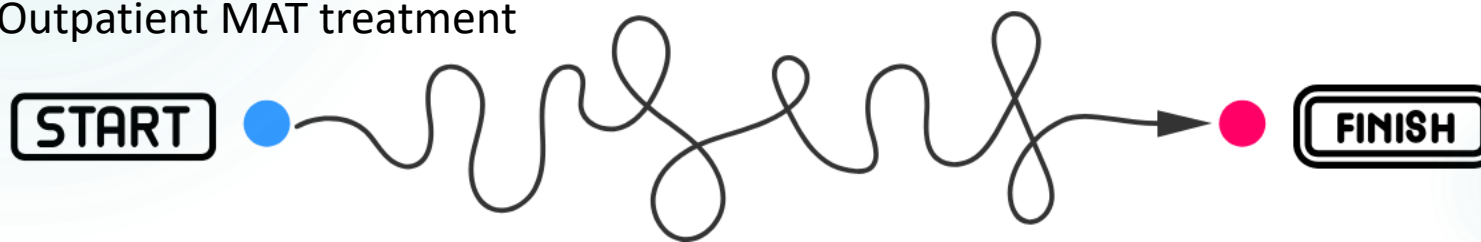
Summerlynn oversees the operations of Mariposa Heritage House's Drop-in Recovery Center, helps to facilitate the Mariposa County Drug Court and Court Mandated Programs, as well as works on the identified needs for Jail Based Services in collaboration with Mariposa County HHSA , Probation and Local Jail Custody Staff. Summerlynn is an Internationally Certified Drug and Alcohol Counselor II, MAT Counselor, DV Counselor and a Co-Occurring Disorder Counselor. Summerlynn previously worked with CDCR as an Intensive Substance Use Disorder and Treatment Counselor and Co-Occurring Disorder Counselor II prior to Joining Mariposa Heritage House.



Re-entry Process Start to Finish



- Case Manager (from Heritage House or HHSA) requests to meet with incarcerated individual, identify if in county or out of county services are needed.
- Willingness to participate - gauge individuals immediate needs and interest and/or ability to actively participate in services.
- Appropriate referrals to meet needs and linkage to community resources - Complete all required ROI's
- Referrals from the jail medical staff and mental health staff:
 - Outpatient behavioral health services
 - Any psychotropic medications prescribed in the jail will be continued once they are assessed by County BH and meet the SMI criteria.
 - Outpatient MAT treatment

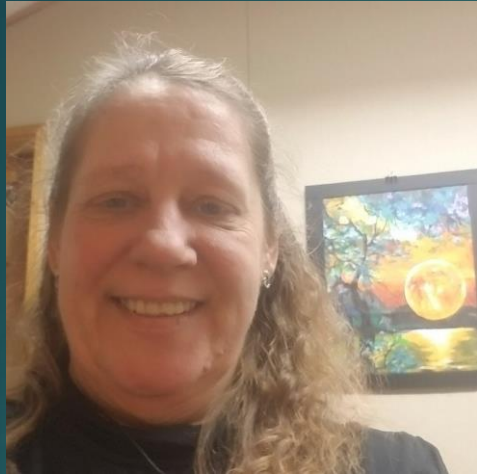

 - What services they need to be linked to or what referrals need to be made based on HRA assessment & other needs discussed.
